CHI Geneva



Created in 1926, the CHI Geneva is one of the world's most prestigious equestrian competitions. Each year, Palexpo welcomes the very best riders and drivers in the world to the biggest indoor arena (5,400m²).

Voted ten times the world's best show jumping competition, the CHI Geneva

is part of the Rolex Grand Slam of Show Jumping, alongside the Dutch Masters of 's-Hertogenbosch (NED), the CHIO Aachen (GER) and the Spruce Meadows "Masters" of Calgary (CAN).

The Geneva International Horse Show has hosted two World Cup Finals (1996 and 2010) as well as sixteen Rolex IJRC

Top 10 Finals. The Indoor Cross Country is also one of the highlights of the event, as is the Driving World Cup. The CHI Geneva is honouring its commitment to young show jumpers by also staging a CSI reserved for under-25 riders.

Each year, 700 highly motivated volunteers bring the event to life and welcome 43,000 spectators over the four days.

In December 2021, the 60th edition of the CHI Geneva proved to be a huge success. Watched by numerous spectators in the packed grandstands, Switzerland's Martin

Fuchs, riding Leone Jei **1**, masterfully retained his title in the Rolex Grand Prix on Sunday. On the Saturday, Ben Maher and Explosion W **2** followed up their gold medal in Tokyo with a win in the 20th Rolex IJRC Top 10 Final. Also on the list of winners at this 60th CHIG was Dutch driver Bram Chardon **3**, who won the Driving World Cup, and Switzerland's Robin Godel **4**, who won the Indoor Cross Country.

The world's best riders and drivers will be returning to Palexpo on 7-11 December. Make sure you're there!
