Created in 1926, the CHI Geneva is one of the world's most prestigious equestrian competitions. Every year, Palexpo welcomes the very best riders and drivers in the world to the biggest indoor arena on the circuit (5,400m²).

Ten times voted the world's best show jumping competition, the CHI Geneva is one of the four majors that make

up the Rolex Grand Slam of Show Jumping, alongside the Dutch Masters in 's-Hertogenbosch (NED), the CHIO Aachen (GER) and the Spruce Meadows "Masters" of Calgary (CAN).

The 61st CHI Geneva lived up to all expectations. First up, there was an extra, fifth day, with free admission for spectators to Jockey Club events and

the tented village, followed by high excitement throughout a near-perfect event. The figures were nothing short of remarkable, with the Palexpo welcoming a record aggregate attendance of nearly 44,000 across five days of passion and celebration, and an unprecedented three sessions (Friday, Saturday evening and Sunday) selling out.

The party ended with US rider McLain Ward's victory on HH Azur **1** in the Rolex Grand Prix, a first major title for the 47-year-old. France's Maxime Livio scored a superb win of his own on Boleybawn Prince **4** in the indoor cross event,

presented by La Tribune de Genève. Among the other notable winners at the 61st CHI Geneva were world No.1 Henrik von Eckermann on King Edward **2** in the 21st Rolex IJRC Top 10 Final, and Brazil's Marlon Modolo Zanotelli on board VDL Edgar M in the Trophée de Genève. In driving, meanwhile, the Netherlands' Bram Chardon **3** held his nerve to win the Geneva round of the FEI Driving World Cup for a second time.

The world's best riders and drivers will be returning to Palexpo on 6-10 December. Make sure you're there to see them!
